Abstract

Given that our lap-tops can now perform solo symphonies, Do we need to listen to each-other anymore? As more and more laptops, MPCs and other computer music devices, invade the contemporary music stage, and we gaze ever longer into the computer screen to produce new music, are we actually losing the ability to communicate and listen to each-other? Do we still listen to each-others music on laptops as well as we did, when we used to close our eyes, and jam on guitars or piano keyboards together?
